In the Classroom

Literacy- This week we will be looking closely at



the characters in the books that we read. We will be describing how characters are feeling and how their feeling change over time. We will also look at the lessons that the characters learn as their

feelings change. In phonics we will learn about the glued sounds ank, ink, onk, unk, ang, ing, ong, and ung.

Writing— We will continue practicing our How To writing. We will be finishing up our current writing and choose a topic for an independent How To.





Math— We will also continue learning about two—dimensional shapes. We will be using the shapes that we have studied to build composite shapes. For example, we might use two trapezoids to build a hexagon,

or three triangles to build a trapezoid.

Social Studies— We will continue our economics unit. We will be learning how people make responsible decisions about spending and saving their money. We will also learn how



supply and demand can impact the price of goods and services.
