Literacy- This week we will work on identifying




details that authors include to make their points. We will work on identifying the main idea and supporting details in nonfiction texts. In phonics, we will continue

learning about silent E.

Writing— We will continue studying a mentor author to improve our own narrative writing. This

week we will be sketching the beginning, middle, and end of our small moment stories. We will also be using our sketches to tell our story to a partner so we can think of more details to add to our sketches before beginning to write.





Math— We will be learning about the meaning of the equal sign (=) this week. We will discuss how the quantities on each side of the equal sign must have the same value. We will use this knowledge to help us

create balanced equalities. For example, we could show the value of 10 in several ways such as: 7+3=10, 7+3=3+7, and 10=8+2.

Science— We will continue learning about rocks and other earth materials. We will be learning about sand, silt, and clay this week.
