In the Classroom

Literacy- This week we will be reviewing story



elements. We will be retelling stories and including story elements like the characters, setting, problem, and solution as we retell. In phonics, we will

continue learning about silent E and vowel teams. Writing— We will continue studying Ezra Jack Keats' books to improve our own writing. This week we will be reviewing the details that Keats includes in his writing to make it interesting. We will be finishing up our first small moment stories and using what we have learned to write a second small moment story.



Math— We will begin learning about two—digit addition. We will be learning strategies such as quick drawings, open number lines, and tens frames to help us solve two—digit addition equations.
