## In the Classroom



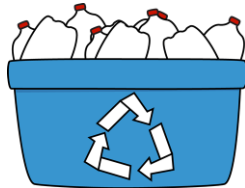
**Literacy**– This week we will continue our end of year reading assessments. We will also continue to practice our reading fluency during our reading group time.
