In the Classroom




Literacy— We will continue building our reading stamina (reading independently for longer periods of time). We will also be talking about the three ways to read a

book: read the pictures, read the words, and retell the story. During phonics we will continue working on lower—case letter formation and reviewing letter sounds.

Writing— We will finish learning the parts of a complete sentence. We will also learn what a small moment story is and begin brainstorming some ideas for our own narratives.





Math— We will finish learning about number partners, including partners of 10. (Ex. 9 and 1, 8 and 2, 7 and 3, etc.) We will also begin learning about place value and how to count large quantities by

making groups of ten with left over ones.

Social Studies— We will finish talking about resolving conflicts when they arise. We will be using "I feel" statements to do this. For example, "I feel distracted when you tap your pencil, please stop."



Homework

Math homework begins this week. Homework will be sent home on Monday in Daily Folders. It should be completed and returned on Friday. First quarter Trick Words were also sent home this week. Please review these words each night. The more Trick Words your child can recognize by sight, the easier reading will be!
